The Methodist Medical Center Laboratory will charge \$25.00 for blood lipids, cholesterol, and blood glucose testing. The charge for thyroid hormone level testing will be \$15.00. These charges are payable when the blood specimen is collected. These tests require no food or drink, except for sips of water, until after the specimen is obtained.

Employees who desire these tests should be scheduled through the Employee Health Station by calling 576-0682 or 576-0680. The technician will only be able to draw blood from 8:30 to 9 a.m. Individuals receiving these tests must be at the Health Fair by 8:30 a.m.
