SUBJECT: MEDIC EMERGENCY BLOOD DRIVE

Medic will hold an emergency blood drive on Wednesday, July 2, 2003, from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. Medic is especially low on all blood types due to the increased number of accidents, surgeries, and donors taking vacations during the summer months.

Donations will be accepted in Rooms B-04 through B-12 of the Federal Building. All donors will receive a free T-shirt and free cholesterol screening at the time of donation. Results of the free cholesterol screening should arrive in the mail within 4 weeks from the date of donation. Donors and individuals claimed as dependents under Internal Revenue Service guidelines will be exempt from paying blood supplier processing fees at any hospital in the United States for 1 year.

No fasting is necessary, and no appointment is required. Positive identification, such as a driver's license, is required for a donation. No donations will be taken from noon to 1 p.m. while Medic employees break for lunch.
