

SAFETY FAIR - UPDATE

All Federal and support service contractor employees are encouraged to participate in the Safety Fair that will be held on May 7, 2009, 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m., in the 2714G Conference Room. Two workshops are being held in conjunction with the Fair and requires sign-up ahead of time for participation. A class on Self-Defense will be held from 9:30 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. in Conference Room C-2 in the 2714 Complex (across the hall from the big 2714G conference room). Also, a class on Exercise Safely at Work or at Home will be held in Conference Room C-2 from 1:30 – 2:00 p.m. You may register for either one of these workshops by calling Susan Blackburn at 576-2113 or email blackburnsh@oro.doe.gov. BSafe Bingo will be played throughout the day in one room inside the big 2714G conference room (look for signs).

The day of the Fair there will be a table set up at the Lea Way entrance to the 2714G conference room for Federal and support service contractor employees to register for door prizes. Drawings will be held every hour. Also at this table, Federal and support contractor employees will need to pick up a ballot to vote for the Booth Contest. Booths eligible for voting will have a large number at the booth that will correspond to the numbers on the ballot. If the weather cooperates, some booths will be outside.

Categories for voting are: Most Innovative Safety Booth, Most Fun Safety Booth, Most Informative Safety Booth, and Most Safety Spirit Booth. Employees will need to vote once for each category and return the ballot to the same table for a nice “thank you for voting” gift.
