

Pursuant to DOE Order 221.1A, "Reporting Fraud, Waste, and Abuse to the Office of Inspector General," this message serves as notification to all Department of Energy (DOE) employees, including National Nuclear Security Administration (NNSA) employees, of their duty to report allegations of fraud, waste, and abuse to the appropriate authorities, including the DOE Office of Inspector General (OIG).

Violations of the ethical restrictions that apply to Federal employees, including the Standards of Conduct for employees of the Executive Branch or the Department's supplement thereto, may be reported to the appropriate Ethics Counselor or directly to the OIG.
