The primary purpose of the Oak Ridge Office (ORO) Operations Security Program (OPSEC) mission is to promote security awareness among all employees. In addition, the OPSEC Program is used to review and assess sensitive programs. The OPSEC Program helps to prevent the exploitation and Unauthorized Disclosure of Sensitive Unclassified Information by developing Countermeasures as well as raising awareness.

Applying some basic OPSEC principles in your everyday life you can help prevent or limit real life dilemmas surrounding identity theft, home burglaries, scams, and other objectionable life changing events.
