SUBJECT: U.S. DEPARTMENT OF ENERGY BLOOD DONOR PROGRAM

Medic will be accepting donations in Rooms B-04 through B-12 of the Federal Building on Thursday, October 25, 2007, from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., in addition to this date the Medic blood mobile will be accepting donations Tuesday, November 6, 2007, from 8 a.m. – 11 a.m., at the Office of Scientific and Technical Information (OSTI). The blood mobile will be located in the OSTI parking lot.

All donors will receive a free T-shirt and free cholesterol screening at the time of donation. Results of the free cholesterol screening should arrive in the mail within 4-6 weeks from the date of donation. Donors and individuals claimed as dependents under Internal Revenue Service guidelines will be exempt from paying blood supplier processing fees at any hospital in the United States for 1 year.

No fasting is necessary, and no appointment is required. Positive identification, such as a driver's license, is required for a donation. No donations will be taken from noon to 1 p.m. while Medic employees break for lunch.
