"During the upcoming 2008 deer hunting season, there will be two nonpublic areas on the Oak Ridge Wildlife Management Area (ORWMA) that will offer hunting opportunities for DOE badged hunters only. All hunters, including those interested in these special areas, must apply through the Tennessee Wildlife Resources Agency (TWRA) application process for quota hunts. These areas, which are clearly marked on this year's hunt map, are open to people with the following DOE badges: Blue-*Q*, Yellow-*L*, Gray-*U* or Green-*Reservation Specific*. There is one area open for shotgun or muzzleloader hunting at the west end of ORNL, just south and west of the main campus. The other area is on the Y-12 property and is open to archery hunting only. This Y-12 area is just north of Bethel Valley Road and west of Scarboro Road. These areas are open during the regular ORWMA quota hunt weekends of November 1-2, November 15-16 and December 6-7. The TWRA applications come out in June and must be submitted around the third week in July. Please see the TWRA website at www.tnwildlife.org for more information.
