

Executive Order 13149, Greening the Government through Federal Fleet and Transportation Efficiency, required Federal Agencies to reduce petroleum consumption through improvements in fleet efficiency and the use of alternative fuel vehicles.

The ORO Federal Building Complex fleet is now comprised of approximately 55 percent E-85 alternative fuel vehicles. During the eight-year process of acquiring alternative fuel vehicles, the Federal Building Complex fuel station offered unleaded gas as well as E-85.

To honor our commitment to the Idaho Operations field office for funding the installation of the onsite fueling station, it is now time to convert the Federal Building Complex fuel station to 100 percent E-85 fuel. This will be done on Thursday, April 10, 2008.

After this conversion, unleaded and diesel fuel should be purchased from local vendors within Oak Ridge or at the Y-12 west-end fueling station at Building 2005. Fuel for the Oak Ridge Federal Building fleet cannot be purchased at the ORNL or ETTP site.
