

The Office of Worker Safety and Health Policy and the National Training Center, both within the Office of Health, Safety and Security (HSS), have produced a new training video entitled “10 CFR 851 Overview.”

The 10 CFR 851 Rule requires that DOE contractor workers are provided with a workplace that is free from recognized hazards that can cause death or serious physical harm. To accomplish this objective, the Rule establishes management responsibilities, worker rights, safety and health standards, and required training. The Rule will replace the Contractor Requirements Document (CRD) of DOE O 440.1A “Worker Protection Management for DOE Federal and Contractor Employees.”

This 15-minute video, available as a stand-alone DVD or as a streaming video on the HSS Web site, provides workers with an overview of 10 CFR 851 and describes workers’ rights and responsibilities under that rule.
