The speaker for this ‘Brown Bag Luncheon’ is Heidi H. Timmerman, ORAU’s Director of Procurement and Contracts Administration. Heidi’s talk will center on how her career path shaped her leadership values: ‘integrity, consistency, compassion and courage’.

Heidi H. Timmerman joined ORAU in September 2009 as Director of Procurement and Contracts Administration. She is responsible for directing the long-range strategic, as well as day-to-day operations for the Procurement and Contracts Administration Department. This includes prime

contracting, Work for Others, small business programs, purchase-card administration, real estate and procurement services.

Timmerman is active in ORAU leadership development programs, holds key roles in special projects, and, brings valuable business expertise to ORAU’s operations. She is involved in the community with participation including the United Way of Anderson County’s Board of Directors, the East Tennessee Economic Council and the National Contracting Management Association. She also participates actively in the Energy Facility Contractors Group (EFCOG) working groups and panels. Timmerman is a 2010 graduate of Leadership Oak Ridge and a 2013 graduate of Leadership Anderson County.

Prior to joining ORAU, Timmerman served as vice president of supply chain operations for IdleAire Inc., and IdleAire Technologies Corporation where she was responsible for product and service support of 131 nationwide locations in addition to construction supply chain. She also served as director of procurement, store services and contracts management for Goody’s Family Clothing. Prior to moving to Tennessee, Timmerman was a senior buyer/planner for manufacturer, Chatsworth Products, Inc. In addition to her commercial experience, Timmerman was a U.S. Marine Corps captain, serving in a variety of roles such as company executive officer, department head and civil process supervisor.

Timmerman has a master’s of business administration from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill and a bachelor’s degree in political science and management from the University of Rochester, N.Y. She also holds certified purchasing manager credentials from the Institute of Supply Management and a Master’s Certificate in Government Contracting from The George Washington University School of Business.
