

The Medic blood mobile will be accepting donations Tuesday, October 9, 2012, from 9 a.m. – 4 p.m. at the 545 Oak Ridge Turnpike Building. Oak Ridge, Tennessee. The blood mobile will be located in the 545 Building parking lot.

All donors will receive a free T-shirt and free cholesterol screening at the time of donation. Results of the free cholesterol screening should arrive in the mail within 4-6 weeks from the date of donation. Donors and individuals claimed as dependents under Internal Revenue Service guidelines will be exempt from paying blood supplier processing fees at any hospital in the United States for 1 year.

No fasting is necessary, and no appointment is required. Positive identification, such as a driver's license, is required for a donation. No donations will be taken from noon to 1 p.m. while Medic employees break for lunch.
