SUBJECT: **RECRUITING TEMPORARY CENSUS WORKERS**

TO: ALL ORO AND OSTI EMPLOYEES

Every ten years, Census information is gathered throughout the United States. This is used to help your community get financial assistance for roads, hospitals, schools and other needs. It also helps your community plan for future child care, educational, health services and recreation needs. This information is important in determining political representation among the States.

Through special waivers to dual employment limitations, the Census Bureau has been granted authority to hire current Federal employees into temporary, part-time second jobs during Census 2000. The Secretary of Energy has agreed to support the Census Bureau's efforts and encourages Department of Energy employees to apply for these temporary jobs.
