**POLICY**

It is the intent of BWXT Y-12, L.L.C. (BWXT Y-12) to comply with all Export Control Laws, Regulations, and Policies of the United States Government, as well as the import laws of other countries. No export will be made contrary to government regulations. Compliance with this will not be compromised for commercial gain.

**SCOPE**

This policy applies to all BWXT Y-12 personnel, including international travelers, are responsible for ensuring that appropriate authority exists to cover their activities with foreign nationals.

An “export” occurs whenever and wherever a commodity or information comes into the hands of a foreign national, whether outside or inside the U. S. The export of products and technologies is controlled by various agencies of the U. S. In many instances, BWXT Y-12 will require an export license for international shipment, technology transfer, or for other methods by which information or products are shared with foreign nationals. The commodity or information to be exported may be subject to export controls due to the technology, end-user, or end-use. Export laws apply not only to physical objects, but also to transfer of information maintained on paper, the software or the data contained on a computer hard drive, or in the mind of an individual. The Export Compliance Manager can provide an explanation of the requirements for appropriate export licensing.

International travel may also require an *import* license for the transfer of information into the country being visited. Prior to commencement of travel, consult with the Export Compliance Manager. Travel to sensitive countries whether official or unofficial also requires a briefing by Counterintelligence.

A violation of export control law, regulations, or policies could subject the individual, as well as BWXT Y-12., to a variety of administrative and criminal penalties. Loss of export privileges would have a significant adverse impact on BWXT Y-12’s ability to remain competitive and perform the BWXT Y-12 mission.
